The Launceston Chamber of Commerce has welcomed the findings of a new report into the proposed Bell Bay Pulp Mill.

The independent report supports the recent comment by the Premier reaffirming her government's support of the project.

The Chamber said that the value to the Northern Tasmanian economy had again been highlighted by the independent survey.

The independent report predicts a nearly \$10 billion boost to the Tasmanian economy between the years 2011 and 2030.

The Chamber has maintained its support of the Bell Bay Pulp Mill project on the basis that it is proved to fulfil prescribed environmental standards.
